## **Indicators of Interest**

#### Statistical & Demographic Data

- # of children receiving mental health/clinical services
- # of children being served in CPS-Family In Home Services (FIH)
- # of children being served in Foster Care (FC)
- # of parent/guardian assessments and mental health service referrals
- Race
- Gender
- Age

#### Diagnoses Data

- By diagnosis comparing all eligible children with children who receive Comprehensive Clinical Assessments (CCAs)
- By diagnosis comparing all eligible children with children who receive Trauma intensive Comprehensive Clinical Assessments (TICCAs) <sup>A</sup>
- By diagnosis comparing Medicaid data for kids with CCAs with TICCAs from Family NET
- By diagnosis (no comparison data) for parent/guardian/caretaker

### Services Provided Data

- Service type for children served
- Service type for children served broken down by Enhanced and E&M Services
- Service type for parent/guardian/caretaker in FIH & FC (child welfare continuum)
- EBP utilized and level of care Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for Outpatient and Family Therapy, Family Centered Treatment, Multisystemic Therapy
- Who uses Child and Adolescent Functional Assessment Scale (CAFAS) tool for all children
- Who uses the Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) tool for all youth ages 6-20 in service areas currently utilizing CAFAS tool

#### **Placement Data**

- Residential data based on level and type of care both pre and during integration period A
- Placement stability data both pre and during integration period <sup>A</sup>
- Placement move "reason" data

#### **Cost Data**

- Average Behavioral Health Expenditures for Foster Care
  Average Behavioral Health Expenditures for Intact Children
- Change in Cost pre/post intervention <sup>A</sup>
