

Creating the Statewide Framework and Infrastructure for Healthy Opportunities



Statewide Resource Platform

- One statewide, shared public utility
- Open to all communities, people, providers, care managers, social service agencies,
- Across all payers, systems, ACOs, populations (e.g. Commercial, Medicare, Medicaid, uninsured), etc
- Knit together healthcare and community services to create a Health System
- Benefits of collaboration and statewide consistency
 - -Uniform system for providers, communities to on-board
 - -Coordinated info as people move across the state
 - -State-wide, regional, community level data across payers
 - -Significant investment by many for development and on-boarding
 - -Cost effective in sharing ongoing expense

NC Resource Platform Functionalities

- Well-curated statewide Resource Database/Data Repository with interface capabilities with local directories
- Referral platform
 - -Generate referrals, close referral loop, promote care coordination, and track outcomes
 - -Ability to connect to other community and service providers No Wrong Door
 - -Shared client record Patient Journey
 - -Community based services providers can use internally to manage their clients
- Public facing user-friendly web-site and a Call Center component for "warmer" help
- Flexible architecture to promote statewide adoption with integration and interface capabilities
- Hands on, heavy touch technical assistance and training to on-board providers and community organizations

Private-Public Partnership

- Program of the Foundation for Health Leadership & Innovation
 - -Fiscal Agent- oversees contracting, budgeting, and reporting to all funders on the project
 - -Vendor Oversight- responsible for vendor selection, contracts, and performance measures.
 - -Stewarding Outcomes- not only overseeing vendor performance but also facilitating data-sharing and evaluation, and convening an Advisory Committee to ensure and support vision and goals are met
 - -Communication Liaison- serving as public-facing entity in communication strategy and messaging surrounding the Platform



Private-Public Partnership

- FHLI holds an MOU with DHHS for TA, coordination with other efforts, data sharing
- Platform has broad-based support, endorsement, and investment of private dollars by insurers, foundations, professional societies, statewide community organizations
- Potential federal dollars (e.g. Administration for Children and Families Kinship Navigation) to support development and roll out
- Goal: Fully funded for first 5 years
- Sustainability plan is to show value before ask of ongoing funding as part of business costs
