Housing is a Healthcare Strategy

"Access to safe, quality and affordable housing – and the supports necessary to maintain that housing – constitute one of the most basic and powerful social determinants of health.

In particular, for individuals and families trapped in a cycle of crisis and housing instability due to poverty, mental illness, addictions or chronic health issues, housing can **entirely** dictate their health and health trajectory."

Addressing Homelessness and Housing

- Financial assistance Programs
- Durham DASH and Home Again (PSH Programs)
- Bridge Housing with master leasing
- Recovery Homes
- Capital Investments
- Homeless Care Review

Health and Housing Program

- In partnership with Duke Health Systems and RHD
 - Began February 2017
 - 13 chronically homeless persons housed with Housing Choice voucher
 - Six persons housed 9-15 months
 - 42 hospital visits six months prior to housing
 - 26 hospital visits since housing (one person accounted for 11 visits)
 - One hospital visit last quarter
 - 75% reduction in ED visits since housing
 - 97% retention rate in housing

Participants Have Complicated Issues

- Mental illness and substance use
 - o Bi-polar Disorder
 - Schizophrenia
 - Cocaine, opioid, alcohol dependence
 - Major Depressive Disorder
 - o PTSD
 - Schizoaffective Disorder

- Physical health
 - Colon, lung, bladder cancer
 - o HIV
 - Multi-level degenerative disc disease
 - Diabetes
 - Hepatitis C
 - Multiple strokes
 - Amputation of lower extremities

Bridge Housing at Harrington Place

In partnership with Wake County and RHD

- o Began March, 2018
- o 3-5 month program
- o 12 units
- Served 17 homeless persons accounting for 1422 months of homelessness
- Six people successfully housed
 - One person re-arrested, one person hospitalized
- 14 of 17 people service connected

What we are Learning about Housing

- It's hard
- It's hard and expensive
- It's not just about affordable housing but safe and decent housing
- It's even harder to do without a case management service definition
- BH providers do not have a proficiency in supportive housing

Transportation

- Contract with Duke, Lincoln Health Clinic and Go Triangle
 - Peer support specialist embedded in Call Center
- Contract with Logisticare
 - Beginning Nov 1st
 - Provide transportation for urgent appointments and follow up after hospital or crisis discharge
- Bus passes
- Real time bus location on Network of Care

What we are Learning about Transportation

- It's hard
- It's even harder in rural or isolated communities without public transportation
- The solution is not always a bus pass

What we are Doing Now

- Piloted the Va Commonwealth Social Needs Assessment with internal Care Teams
- Figuring out our data metrics for SDOH
- Researching the Silicone Valley Housing Triage tool
- Working with the Corporation for Supportive Housing
- Convened a SDOH Think Tank
