Volunteer Training Pre/Post Average Score Increase

Spring 2013		27.8%
Fall 2012	32.7 %	
Spring 2012		24.8%
Fall 2011	32.7%	
Spring 2011		22.25%
Fall 2010	29 %	
Spring 2010		27.3%

Overall Average of 28.08% increase Individual improvement from 45% to -5%



Pre/Post Tests – Returning Students

20 – 40 hours (MSI) 27.88% increase 40 – 80 hours (MSII) 35.33 % increase

Retention after one month: 7.7% decrease Retention after one year: 12.7% decrease
