

MomsRising.org is an online and on-the-ground grassroots organization of more than a million people who are working to achieve economic security for all families in the United States.



Changes in Wireless Internet Use by Demographic Groups, 2009 to the Future





Changes in Wireless Internet Use by Demographic Groups, 2009 to the Future





Four Key Principles:



- 1. Stay nimble and responsive
- 2. Constantly test
- 3. Maintain the dialogue
- 4. Open as many engagement avenues as possible

Lessons Learned:

- Pay attention to themes or stories that resonate with certain communities and not others
- Keep messages positive and direct
