

If you care about these issues, you care about child development.






Long-term Goal

Create a culture that prioritizes young children and acts to ensure that each young child has the opportunity to succeed.

Context

- Early childhood discussed in terms of programs--many of which were complicated and hard to understand how they worked.
- No unifying message for the many groups engaged in early childhood issues.
- Diminishing public investment.




Approach

- Create an accessible, opensource, initiative that could serve as an umbrella message.
- Cultivate unexpected voices to serve as ambassadors.
- Provide opportunities for varying levels of engagement.
- Build engagement **capacity** at the local level.



Accessible Open Source Big Picture

- What may think is old news, may not be for most people.
- Place issue in contexts that audience cares about.
- Need to answer, "What's in it for me?"




ASHEVILLE — A lot happens in the first 2,000 days of a child's life.

The connections inside the brain are formed that affect things like problem solving and social skills.

Now a statewide campaign dubbed the "First 2000 Days" aims to raise awareness about how crucial those early years are. The effort aims to connect the dots between what happens in those early years and the impact on the economy and other long-term measures.

"Eighty-five to 90 percent of a child's critical brain development happens during that time period, those first 2,000 days," Kit Cramer,

president and CEO of the Asheville Area Chamber of Commerce, recently told a group at the Community Foundation of Western North Carolina.




