Average 77 children in custody

54% (42 children) placed in a regular foster home/level 1/group home care/medical hospital setting

- Had an average of 3.2 moves per child
- Reasons for moves:
 - o Home unable to manage behavior
 - o Respite
 - o Independent living program/Job Corps
 - o Child's mental health not able to be met in the approved level of care
 - o Inpatient hospital initiated the higher level of care or a move to another placement
- 19% (8 children) were placed 60 miles beyond county line—all in a group home setting/independent living shelter/home

29% (22 children) placed in a Level II home

- Had an average of 4.3 moves per child
- Reasons for moves:
 - o Unable to manage behavior
 - o Inpatient hospital initiated the higher level of care or a move to another placement
- All placed within 60 miles of county line

13% (10 children) placed in a Level III home

- Had an average of 2 moves per child
- Reasons for moves:
 - o Unable to manage behavior
 - Inpatient hospitalization/threating behaviors
 - o Committed a crime and involved with adult justice system
 - o Ran away
 - Substance use
- 80% (8 children) were placed 60 miles beyond county line

3% (2 children) placed in a PRTF/jail

- Had an average of 6.4 moves per child
- Reasons for moves:
 - o Committed a crime and involved with adult justice system
 - o Ran away
 - Self-injurious behaviors/drug use
- All were placed 60 miles beyond county line

Guardianship:

- 57 wards
 - o 52 have a primary mental health diagnosis
 - o 24 in a mental health group home and/or hospital living setting
 - o 1 in jail
 - o 15 were involved with Child welfare prior to turning 18
 - o 4 transferred to guardianship at the age of 18 from foster care
- Average of 3 moves of the 52 of those with a mental health diagnosis
 - o Reasons for moves
 - increased behavioral issues,
 - running away,
 - increase in Involuntary Commitments to assist in managing client's behaviors
- 11 placed beyond 60 miles from county line
