

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


Task Force on Accountable Care Communities

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Description

Individuals' health outcomes often have more to do with the conditions in which they live than with their genetic makeup. Addressing the social, behavioral, and economic factors (e.g., housing, transportation, and food access) that influence health outcomes is a key strategy for improving health. Accountable Care Communities (ACCs) are an emerging promising model for addressing the social, behavioral, and economic factors that influence health outcomes from a community perspective, pulling multiple cross-sector stakeholders together in a coordinated effort to improve health outcomes.

The NCIOM Task Force on Accountable Care Communities will meet approximately twice a year to discuss and support the development of accountable care communities and guidelines that will improve health outcomes.

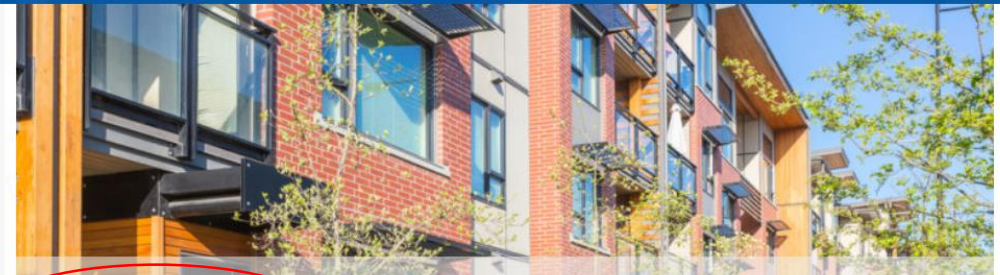
