Program Goals:


- To improve (reduce) North Carolina's maternal and neonatal morbidity and mortality rates
- To improve birth outcomes through the reduction in unintended pregnancies

Strategies to Complete Goals:

- Establishing a system to determine risk appropriate levels of maternal and neonatal care
- Promoting the development of collaborative systems that promote proactive integration of risk-appropriate antepartum, intrapartum, and postpartum care
- Increasing the availability of immediate postpartum insertion of highly effective, long-acting contraceptive methods
