**2007 Update** on Task Force on the North Carolina Nursing Workforce

#### Areas not implemented as of 2007:


- Additional funding for AHEC, NC Community College System for specific activities
- Additional funding for nurse aide salaries in facilities reliant on Medicaid
- Revision to nursing school admission criteria
- Promotion and funding for dual enrollment academic programs
- Additional training for guidance counselors
- Income tax credit for nursing students

\*\* A work group will review status of recommendations and determine lessons learned.

#### **Recommendation Development Process**

- 1. Initial learning and discussions with task force
  - February & March
- 2. Initial discussions and development of potential recommendations with work groups
  - April & May
- 3. NCIOM staff draft potential recommendations based on work group discussion; share draft recommendations with steering committee for comment
  - June
- 4. Share draft recommendations with task force and discuss
  - July & August
- 5. Additional reflection and discussion with work groups
  - September
- 6. NCIOM staff edit/adjust/add to recommendations as needed
  - September & October
- 7. Share revised recommendations with task force and discuss
  - October & November
- 8. Edit/adjust as needed
- 9. Final discussion with task force
  - December



#### **Task Force Member Roles**

- 1) Attend task force meetings when able or review summaries if unable to attend
- 2) Share your expertise and perspective discussions, chat comments, email, one-on-one meetings, office hours
- 3) Review draft recommendations and provide comment
- 4) Review draft report text and provide comment
