Shaping Policy for a Healthier North Carolina

For more than 40 years, the NCIOM has shaped health policy in North Carolina by identifying solutions to the state's health challenges. Our work has helped improve the health and well-being of North Carolinians and has positively changed how health care is delivered.

To do our work, the NCIOM:

- Convenes task forces to identify evidence-based solutions to address health issues in North Carolina
- Convenes and educates health policy stakeholders
- Publishes the NCMJ (North Carolina Medical Journal)
- Provides non-partisan research and analysis on health and health care in North Carolina

Innovations in Health Care

Each year, the NCIOM hosts our **Annual Meeting as a platform for conversations about important health policy topics impacting North Carolina**. This year, we will focus on innovations in health care—from artificial intelligence to telehealth—and examine impacts shaping policy and costs at the federal and state level as well as care delivery in local communities.

Breakout topics will include:

- **Workforce innovations**, including AI-enabled tools, remote monitoring, and robotics in health care settings
- **Technology and access to care**, from telehealth and virtual care to wearable technology and mobile health apps
- **Quality of care**, including machine learning and impacts of technology on patient experience, use cases for predictive analytics, and application of targeted telemedicine
- **Innovations and equity**, from community-centered partnerships and decentralized care models to data-driven tools and algorithm-improved diagnosis and care processes

Dr. Brian Anderson, Chief Executive Officer, Coalition for Health AI (CHAI)



Dr. Brian Anderson is the CEO and co-founder of the Coalition for Health AI (CHAI), a nonprofit organization advancing responsible and trustworthy use of artificial intelligence in health care. Prior to his current role, Dr. Anderson served as Chief Digital Health Physician at MITRE, where he led major national digital health initiatives, including support for the White House COVID-19 response and AI-driven innovations in oncology and clinical research. Dr. Anderson is an internationally recognized author and expert in digital health and is regularly engaged as a speaker on digital health innovation, health standards development, clinical decision support systems, and interoperability.
